Top Ten— **Keith Urban** is at the No. 1 spot this week with "Somewhere In My Car." **Blake Shelton**'s "Neon Light" is up one spot to No. 2 followed by **Jason Aldean**, also up one, with "Burnin' It Down" at No. 3. **Maddie & Tae** gain two spots with "Girl In A Country Song" landing at No. 4. **Scotty McCreery**'s "Feelin' It" remains at No. 5 for another week. **Brad Paisley** jumps three spots with "Perfect Storm" at No. 6. **Rascal Flatts** remain at No. 7 with "Payback" and **Frankie Ballard** sits again at No. 8 with "Sunshine & Whiskey." **Tim McGraw**'s "Shotgun Rider" breaks the Top Ten and lands at No. 9. **Brothers Osborne** remain at No. 10 with "Rum."

Greatest Gainers— **Florida Georgia Line** make their debut on the chart with "Sun Daze" and had the highest gain with 452 new spins. **Toby Keith** also makes his debut with "Drunk Americans" thanks to an increase of 442 plays. **Kenny Chesney** continues his climb with "Til It's Gone" up 430 plays followed by **Carrie Underwood**'s "Something In The Water" up 403. **Tim McGraw**'s "Shotgun Rider" makes the Top Ten after 311 new spins.

Debuts— **Toby Keith** had the highest debut week with "Drunk Americans" at No. 51. **Florida Georgia Line**'s "Sun Daze" was also seen on the chart for the first time at No. 60. **Cole Swindell** debuts at No. 70 with "Ain't Worth The Whiskey." **Kristian Bush** is at No. 76 with "Trailer Hitch."

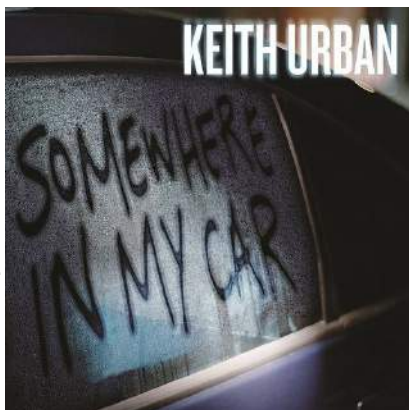

Lisa Smoot/Jerry Duncan Promotions

How did you get into the radio promotions business?

I was one of those people that showed up to radio remotes, entered all the contests, etc. I would call the radio station and end up talking to the DJ for an hour or so...I didn't know I was preparing for my future job! I came to Nashville in 2004. I started with Jerry Duncan Promotions on January 5, 2004 and now I'm a LIFER!

What is your favorite thing about your work?

I remember working my first major breakthrough artist, Jason Aldean. We had to make sure radio knew how to pronounce his last name. They were asking is "al dean" or "all dean"? My second major breakthrough was with Florida Georgia Line. Can I just say, "I want to "Stay" "Round Here" and "Cruise" while you "Get Your Shine On." I will show you "This Is How We Roll" while waiting on "Dirt" to go No. 1! When we hit No. 1 with "Dirt," it was Jerry Duncan Promotions' 70th No. 1 hit!

Tell us about one of your proudest accomplishments?

I would have to say the latest accomplishment I am proud of, is radio helping us getting Clare Dunn "Get Out" to No. 15 on the *MusicRow* Chart. She is the highest charting Independent female in 10 years.

What is an interesting fact about yourself that others may not know?

Oh lawd! There is so much... I get a lot of "TMI" from guys when I'm talking on the phone with them. I gave up my audition on Last Comic Standing because it was the same day as the CRS *MusicRow* Meet & Greet. That's HOW MUCH I LOVE THIS JOB AND THESE GUYS!
