Greatest Gainers—Florida Georgia Line had the biggest gain this week with 486 new spins for "Sun Daze." Kenny Chesney moved into the Top 10 after 401 new plays for "Til It's Gone." The Swon Brothers have the highest debut this week with "Pray For You" and the 335 additional spins. Lady Antebellum's "Freestyle" moves up the chart thanks to 326 new spins. Eric Church moves closer to the top spot after 313 more plays for "Talladega."

The girls have done it! **Maddie** & Tae, the first act signed to Big Machine Label Group's Dot Records, have landed at No. 1 on this week's CountryBreakout Chart with "Girl In A Country Song."

The title, written by the 19year-old Oklahoma and Texas natives together with coproducer **Aaron Scherz**, has become the fastest-moving and

best-selling female debut single since Carrie Underwood's "Jesus Take The Wheel," eight years ago. "Girl In A Country Song" has certainly made national waves as it has unashamedly bashed the clichés of the bro-Country movement.

The cheeky track appeared on the *MusicRow* Chart 16 weeks ago, and has since been purchased by 350k fans, and has since been bundled with three companion tracks for the duo's EP, which went on sale this week (Nov. 4).

Maddie & Tae were recently <u>incorporated</u> into CMT's Next Women of Country franchise. <u>Catch them on the road</u> from Nashville to Las Vegas, through the end of the year.

How long have you been at the station? 10 years

How many "hats" do you wear each day? Operations Manager/Program Director/Music Director/Afternoon Drive Air Personality

What is your philosophy on adding new music to your playlist?

I add based on what I think my listeners would prefer, and I also look at the currents we have already in rotation in an attempt to offer variety. Since we play quite a bit of Gold, we only rotate about 37 currents at any one time.



What role do promoters play in your decisions? Promoters provide useful information on artists, and allow me to work with them and share my views on the new music they are promoting. Why is it important for you to report to *MusicRow*? It's very important. We are all stewards of this thing called Country Music. It takes all of us, to make this genre work.

Tell us something GREAT about your station and/or city? (Feel free to BRAG!) Only station that I've programmed that has won Marconi Small Market Station of the Year, AND a NAB Crystal Award all in the same year (2013).

Who are some NEW artists that you're excited about? Erica Nicole, Brett Eldridge, Amber Hayes, Chris Young, Rachel Holder, Marianne Allison, David Nail, just to name a few.
